Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and plainly marked to indicate the subject of the bid and addressed to the Purchasing Agent, Purchasing Office, Township of Randolph, 502 Millbrook Avenue, Randolph, NJ 07869. **Any envelope that is received that is not properly marked causing it to be opened prior to the bid will be invalidated.** Bids may be received before the hour designated in this office if they are mailed or hand-delivered in person. The Township will not be responsible for any bid that is sent by mail or other form of carrier which is lost or which arrives after the bid deadline date and time.

BID SPECIFICATIONS**CONTRACT #14: CATCH BASINS & MANHOLE CASTINGS**

Contract Period: January 1, 2025 - December 31, 2025

THE FOLLOWING ARE MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS WHICH MUST BE MET OR EXCEEDED.

This is an Open-Ended contract, meaning all items are specified with an estimated quantity. THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENTS CONTRACT. There is no obligation to purchase that quantity during the contract period, and the actual quantity purchased by members of the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (MCCPC) may vary. Members of the MCCPC are not required to purchase exclusively from the awarded vendor(s).

All quantities may be more or less than estimated. The successful vendor cannot establish a minimum order requirement. However, the MCCPC may, in certain instances, establish minimum order requirements which will be noted on the Bid Proposal Form.

The estimated quantities listed on the Bid Proposal Form are total quantities anticipated, not total quantities to one location.

Prices are to remain firm for the term of the contract with no exceptions.

Bidders to specify delivery days after receipt of an order. Delivery time is not factored into the calculation to determine the successful vendor. Bidders failing to stipulate a guaranteed delivery date will be held to delivery within five (5) business days after receipt of order.

Bidders must specify manufacturer or brand name and manufacturer's number they are bidding for each item specified. Bidders are to bid ONE manufacturer/brand for each item in the category. Items listing more than one manufacturer/brand will result in the rejection of the bid for that category.

Bidders must bid on all items within those categories for which they are submitting a bid. However, if ALL bidders do not bid on the same item, that particular item will be removed from the list and the remaining items will be used to determine the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. **If at least one bidder bids on all items, that bidder will get the contract if they are responsive and responsible.**

Bidders are not required to bid on all categories.

Items to be priced each, as required, for each size and type delivered. All items must be off-loaded by the vendor in the location as directed by the MCCPC member.

Delivery Locations (if applicable): To participating members of the MCCPC at various locations as specified at the time of order, FOB Destination, Freight Prepaid.

All materials shall conform with the applicable requirements in the respective articles of the NJDOT 2019 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, latest edition, with all the latest and applicable requirements and supplements.

DETAILED ITEMS SPECIFIED IN PROPOSAL FORM: (All materials must meet current stormwater regulations)

Category A: Curb Catch Basins

Category B: Single & Double Frame Grates

Category C: Manholes – prices bid are to include any cost for a die charge; no extra charges will be allowed

CATCH BASIN COVER ASSEMBLY SPECIFICATIONS**General – NJDOT Approved:**

This specification is for a catch basin opening cover assembly system. It should comprise a covering plate member having a sufficient number of openings of predetermined area and dimension so as to comply with existing state regulations and/or specifications and a plurality of mount openings available to secure the cover to the basin. The cover member will be available in a multitude of contours and opening configurations so as to meet the aforementioned specification and to provide sufficient cover for the variety of catch basin openings to be found in the field.

Further, the assembly shall include means for clamping the covering member to the catch basin which provide a firm and secure attachment. The means of clamping shall be a cam action device for each mount opening. The cam device is to be mounted to the cover member using a single bolt through each mount opening. The cam device shall pivot on the interior surface of the cover member in response to the advance of the securing bolt. The cam device shall have at least two contact prongs that eventually contact the interior surface of the catch basin as the bolt is advanced so as to provide two points of pressure against the interior surface of the basin for each cam device to secure the covering member to the basin.

The retrofit steel cover plate and associated parts are to be manufactured in the United States of America. All manufacturers shall be able to demonstrate that there is an acceptable quality control program in place at the producing manufacturer prior to supplying product.

Materials:

Retrofit steel plate and cam device shall be manufactured from 0.25" thick, Corten brand or equivalent, over 60,000 psi high strength/low alloy weathering steel, and conform to A588 grade.

Mounting bolts shall be of the button head cap configuration made of steel alloy, for example, 10-18 steel and shall conform in all respects to ASTM F835.

Additional metal piece(s) shall be made of 10-18 steel alloy.

Manufacturer:

Retrofit steel plate shall be of uniform quality, of holes, shapes and bends. Plate shall be reasonably smooth of surface and edge. Plate dimensional tolerance shall be +/- 1/32 inch per foot. No finish is required on Corten or equivalent steel. Material oxidizes to create its own weather barrier.

Inspection:

Quality inspection of part geometry by manufacturer.

Certification:

To be furnished to the purchaser upon request.

Markings:

Each plate will have a stainless steel badge with blue background mechanically welded and recessed into the center of the plate reading: NO DUMPING, DRAINS TO WATERWAY, MADE IN USA with a fish symbol.

For 6" Covers:

2" x 3" stainless steel badge embossed with: NO DUMPING, DRAINS TO WATERWAYS, MADE IN USA with a fish symbol. Welded and recessed. Badge to have blue background.

For 8" Or Larger Covers:

3" diameter stainless steel badge embossed with: NO DUMPING, DRAINS TO WATERWAYS, MADE IN USA with a fish symbol. Welded and recessed. Badge to have blue background.

Phase II Eco Safe Bar or Equivalent For Series 2500 (or) 2600 Curb Inlets:

1/2" x 2" steel plate welded to bar with engraved inscription: Dump No Waste, Drains to Waterways.

Bidders shall take the current and possible future supply chain cost impacts and inflation into account when putting their bid pricing proposal together. The MCCPC will not entertain requests for price increases during the awarded contract term.

Award of Contract:

Award of contract will be made to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder based upon the lowest aggregate total per category. (4 awards)
