Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and plainly marked to indicate the subject of the bid and addressed to the Purchasing Agent, Purchasing Office, Township of Randolph, 502 Millbrook Avenue, Randolph, NJ 07869. **Any envelope that is received that is not properly marked causing it to be opened prior to the bid will be invalidated.** Bids may be received before the hour designated in this office if they are mailed or hand-delivered in person. The Township will not be responsible for any bid that is sent by mail or other form of carrier which is lost or which arrives after the bid deadline date and time.

BID SPECIFICATIONS

CONTRACT #23: POLICE UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT

Contract Period: January 1, 2025 - December 31, 2025

THE FOLLOWING ARE MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS WHICH MUST BE MET OR EXCEEDED.

This is an Open-Ended contract, meaning all items are specified with an estimated quantity. **THIS IS NOT A REQUIREMENTS CONTRACT.** There is no obligation to purchase that quantity during the contract period, and the actual quantity purchased by members of the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (MCCPC) may vary. Members of the MCCPC are not required to purchase exclusively from the awarded vendor(s).

All quantities may be more or less than estimated. The successful vendor cannot establish a minimum order requirement. However, the MCCPC may, in certain instances, establish minimum order requirements which will be noted on the Bid Proposal Form.

The estimated quantities listed on the Bid Proposal Form are total quantities anticipated, not total quantities to one location.

Approximate sizes of orders cannot be provided as members are not required to purchase minimum amounts or place one annual order.

Prices are to remain firm for the term of the contract with no exceptions.

Where items on the Bid Proposal Form or in the Bid Specifications indicate an item (patch/flag/collar tabs/etc.) is to be provided and/or provided and sewn on by the vendor, bidders are to include that cost in their bid price.

Specific product information is indicated on the Bid Proposal Form. **Bidders MUST indicate the manufacturer or brand name they are bidding, otherwise bidders will be held to providing the manufacturer/brand specified. Bidders are to bid ONE manufacturer/brand for each item. Items listing more than one manufacturer/ brand name will result in rejection of the bid for that category.**

If the MCCPC does not specify a manufacturer or brand and the bidder does not provide a manufacturer or brand, the bid for that particular category will be rejected as non-responsive.

For any item where bidders are offering an "equivalent", the bidder MUST provide with the bid proposal product details in a 1-page printout from the manufacturer. It is the responsibility of the bidder to provide the information as requested. The MCCPC will not be responsible for researching the item for compliance. Items that cannot be verified with the information provided by the bidder will be rejected.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF CONTRACTOR

Delivery Days: Required time of delivery – maximum 15 business days ARO.

Custom Made Items: Required time of delivery – maximum 30 business days ARO.

Delivery Locations (if applicable): To participating members of the MCCPC to various locations as specified at the time of order, FOB Destination, Freight Prepaid.

Bidders must bid on all items within the category in which they are submitting a bid. However, if ALL bidders do not bid on the same item, that particular item will be removed from the list and the remaining items will be used to determine the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. **If at least one bidder bids on all items, that bidder will get the contract if they are responsive and responsible.**

Bidders must provide pricing for Regular and Extra Large shirt and blouse sizes. Bidding on Tall sizes is an option and will not be used in the determination of the award. Prices for optional embroidery will not be used in the determination of the award.

Bidders are not required to bid on all categories.

Vendor must maintain sufficient stock to handle contract.

Vendor must be in the uniform business at least three (3) years.

Vendors must provide “On-Site” fitting and alterations for no additional charge. In addition to a salesperson, an experienced tailor/seamstress must come on-site to measure. Vendor will be responsible for the delivery of uniforms and equipment for no additional charge.

To facilitate proper fitting, the successful bidder must have a properly staffed and equipped store with an experienced alteration department.

Thread color for sewing all collar tabs/patches/hash marks/etc. except military (red) is to match thread used for the embroidered name and badges.

All alterations must be included in the purchase price. No additional charges will be allowed for any alterations made.

NOTE: Under this contract, the vendor supplying uniforms that require embroidered patches/badges noted in the specifications is required to provide the MCCPC member agency with the artwork/electronic file(s) used to fabricate the patches/badges. The artwork/electronic file(s) remains/becomes the property of the MCCPC member agency.
